

Worst Case Scenario-

Student indicates that s/he is at **imminent risk** of suicide or homicide

- Call 911
- If you do not have the student's address/telephone number to share with the 911 operator, check the university's online directory at <http://www.mid.muohio.edu/directory/> . You will need to log in at the bottom of the directory listing in order to view hidden fields.
- Telephone Campus Security at 513-727-3333. You will receive a call as soon as possible from a university administrator.

Moderate Concern Scenario-

Although student does not appear to be at imminent risk of harming self or others, faculty member is extremely concerned that the student may be at risk in the near future.

During normal working hours (8-5 weekdays):

Telephone Student Services ASAP at 513-727-3431 or 727-3440

OR

stop by the office in Room 1 Johnston Hall to discuss the situation.

Outside normal working hours (evenings, weekends, holidays):

Telephone Campus Security at 513-727-3333. You will receive a call as soon as possible from Nancy Ferguson (Coordinator of Counseling & Disability Services) or June Fening (Assistant Dean).

Low Concern Scenario-

Faculty member is concerned about the well-being of a student due to apparent depression, anxiety, or other mental health issue.

OR

stop by the office in Room 1 Johnston Hall to discuss the situation.
