Regional Campus Committee Preliminary Recommendations

LC members voiced concern over the use of the term “remedial” in the Regional Campus Committee’s preliminary recommendations and further indicated that there is a difference between “developmental” and “remedial.” The concern about moving “remedial” classes to other institutions is that if MUM faculty do not teach the classes, the students will not be where they need to be for college-level classes in those areas.
