
#### Cozy Season is Upon Us: What Are You Reading?





## Describing the View

As we share a range of pictures within our newsletter, including autumn leaves, books, movies, and video game covers, we want to highlight the importance of describing images within your digital files with full descriptions or alt text.

What is the difference between descriptions and alt text? The alt text option provides details about what is in an image, including text or basic essential details. Whereas an image description gives more detail beyond the alt text.
