
NAVIGATING THE INFORMATION UNIVERSE



Your mid semester check-in from the library

What do you know and what do you want to see in the Library?

This fall we conducted a short survey to find out more about what students use and want to see done by our library. Here are some of the highlights.

- Only 50% of students were aware the library offered:
 - * Curbside pickup (43%)
 - * Research consultations (30%)
 - * Home delivery (24%)
 - * LOLA (23%)
- In contrast, students were most aware of Study rooms (78%), Asking questions by chat, text, and email (64%), E-books (64%), and laptops (60%)
- 73% of our respondents are aged 18-24 and 48% have Middletown as their primary campus

A couple of suggestions from respondents included providing more instructions on how to navigate databases and search, and sending out fun videos and photos of the library to remind students about our services. Based on these suggestions, we offer an introduction to a new library aid, Theo-Saurus!

Gardner-Harvey Library Dinosaur, Theo-Saurus, has the Answers!


